#### The 1918 "Spanish" Flu Pandemic

- Est 50-100 million deaths worldwide
- Est 2.5% mortality in young, healthy adults due to:
  - acute onset of ARDS-like syndrome "cytokine storm"
  - necrotizing bronchopneumonia, often w/ secondary bacterial infection

## Imagine....

- how many lives would have been saved w/ a vaccine that was ~95% effective at prevention of ICU admissions/deaths if everyone were vaccinated
- how many preventable deaths would have occurred if half the population declined to take the vaccine

• Est. 100,000 U.S. deaths

## Imagine....

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March 12, 2003: W.H.O. issues Global Alert about a newly recognized cause of severe, often lethal pneumonia that began in November of 2002 about which China was initially silent

- No effective treatment; no vaccine
- Rapid spread to 37 countries, including Canada and U.S.
- >8000 cases / >800 deaths. Significant human human transmission
   w/ 10% mortality Ro = 3
- Ultimately found to be due to a novel coronavirus SARS-CoV

## Scientists were close to a coronavirus vaccine years ago. Then the money dried up.

We just could not generate much interest," a researcher said of the difficulty in getting funding to test the vaccine in humans.



- Background: prior to this study, the cure rate for syphilis was ~30%, followings months of toxic, sometimes lethal mercury and arsenic
- In 1932, the U.S. Public Health Service, working with the Tuskegee Institute, began a study called the "Tuskegee Study of Untreated Syphilis in the Negro Male" to record the natural history of (untreated) syphilis.
- Some AA persons in leadership as well as the NMA supported this study. Others have argued, at least prior to penicillin, that the treatment might have been worse than the disease

- Under the guise of free medical care, 399 black males, mostly sharecroppers from Macon County, Alabama, diagnosed with syphilis were treated for "bad blood" w/ placebo from 1932 until the time of their death
- This non-treatment continued even after penicillin became available in 1947 and was recommended as treatment for syphilis!! (participants were not told of the availability of treatment nor given information regarding opting out of the study)

- This same non-treatment continued until concerns were raised in 1968 and again, more publicly, in 1972 about the ethics of continuing to withhold known effective treatment.
- Within a month of these concerns being made public in 1972, the study was finally halted

- As a result of this continued unethical nontreatment, many of these individuals infected others and many developed the numerous complications of tertiary and neurosyphilis, including aortitis, blindness, dementia, stroke...
- Most members of the African-American community are well aware of this study

   (Early 1900s: ~100/yr), but.....
- 40,000 annual exposures \$\$\$\$

#### Worldwide:

• 55,000 deaths/yr!

#### Tetanus



- •~29 cases/yr (U.S.); 2 deaths
- Worldwide: still 59,000 deaths, 200,000 cases/yr

How many of you have ever seen a case of measles within the continental U.S.?

#### Measles

- In the U.S., prior to vaccine (1963):
  - 2 4 million cases; 400 500 deaths/yr
- ~1980: est. 2.6 million deaths/yr (worldwide)
- New: (est) over 207,000 deaths from measles in 2020 from breakdown in health care delivery as result of Covid-19, EBOLA and war
- Estimated 21,000,000 measles deaths prevented worldwide since 2000 by vaccination (Paules et al NEJM June 6, 2019)



- This same question could be asked of multiple serious and often devastating communicable diseases e.g.
  - hepatitis A, B
  - rubella
  - H. influenza meningitis
  - polio
  - smallpox
  - and more...

What do all of these have in common, and why have you most likely never seen a case?

They are all nearly 100% preventable by immunization - as are many others, though many vaccines may not approach this degree of efficacy



"For Sars in 2003, it took four months before the genome sequence of the coronavirus was available.....

The first human trial of a possible Sars vaccine was conducted in Beijing in December 2004, but by that time the epidemic was over, and research into other diseases was given priority so it was shelved."

"Seventeen years after the severe acute respiratory syndrome (Sars) outbreak and seven years since the first Middle East respiratory syndrome (Mers) case, there is still no coronavirus vaccine despite dozens of attempts to develop them."\*

#### Some take homes:

- In order for a vaccine to work, it must first be given!
- In order for a vaccine to be developed, the risk must first be recognized and the response must be rapid and effective
- Re: Covid-19 the warnings were there. We just chose to ignore or otherwise prepare for what would ultimately kill millions!
- This is not the last pandemic!!!
